Please don't bring a car!



Welcome to the 5th largest city in the *USA* – *Philadelphia*! Parking in the city is a challenge. We urge our resident students not to bring a car to campus.

There are four institutions in *University City*; *University of Pennsylvania*, *Drexel University*, *University of the Sciences* and *Walnut Hill College*. Some numbers to consider:

- ✓ 52,000 combined students
- ✓ 17,000 students living on campuses
- ✓ 49,000 residents in *University City*
- ✓ 61,000 people come into *University City* each day for work and school

That is a lot of people AND a lot of cars!

The college has one small parking lot for students. It is open only during the day from Monday to Saturday. There is no overnight parking. Parking is extremely limited and on a “first-come-first-served” basis. This small lot is generally filled by 7:00 AM.

There are paid parking lots, but many of them are not close to our campus. The day rates range from \$20 to \$30. Monthly rates average \$180 to \$220. A car in *University City* is not a great idea!
