Please don't bring a car!



Welcome to the fifth largest city in the United States, *Philadelphia*! Due to the city's popularity, finding parking is a challenge. Therefore, we urge our students who live on campus not to bring a car.

There are four institutions in *University City*: Walnut Hill College, The University of Pennsylvania, Drexel University, and The University of the Sciences. Some stats to consider:

- ✓ 52,000 combined students
- ✓ 17,000 students living on campuses
- ✓ 49,000 residents in University City
- ✓ 61,000 people come into University City each day for work and school

That is a lot of people AND a lot of cars!

The College has one small parking lot for students. It is open only during the day from Monday through Saturday. There is no overnight parking. Parking is extremely limited and on a first come, first served basis. This small lot is generally filled by 7:00 am.

There are paid parking lots in the area, but many of them are not close to our campus. The day rates at these lots can range from \$20 to \$30, while monthly rates average from \$180 to \$220. As we hope you can see, having a car in University City is not a great idea!
