



## **Business Attire and Acceptable Business Casual Attire**



### *Business Attire*

- ▀ You will be in business attire for 3 ½ days
- ▀ You can, if you wish, be in casual business attire for the other 2 ½ days
- ▀ If you prefer to be in business attire for the full week you certainly may
- ▀ Some students find it easier to only pack business attire
- ▀ Others prefer business attire if they go to nice restaurants in Paris
- ▀ Remember: following the dress code is part of your grade

## How to dress each day during your Gastronomic Tour of France

| Day                   | Dress code      | Comments                |
|-----------------------|-----------------|-------------------------|
| Saturday – travel day | Business casual | Or business if you wish |
| Sunday night dinner   | Business attire | All day                 |
| Monday – all day      | Business attire | All day                 |
| Tuesday – all day     | Business attire | All day                 |
| Wednesday – all day   | Business attire | All day                 |
| Thursday – all day    | Business casual | Or business if you wish |
| Friday – all day      | Business casual | Or business if you wish |



### *Business Casual*

- 🇫🇷 Business casual is NOT “casual”
- 🇫🇷 It is professional attire that is not as formal
- 🇫🇷 Think, shirts with buttons, professional pants, professional shoes
- 🇫🇷 You can, if you wish, stay in full business attire for the week
- 🇫🇷 Some students find it easier and prefer it
- 🇫🇷 Do NOT bring:
  - ✓ Jeans
  - ✓ Tee shirts
  - ✓ Sweat shirts
  - ✓ Sneakers
