TUITION

- **\$32,475** per academic year
 - Includes books, technology & lab fees, international travel experiences
 - **WHC Tuition Pledge:** As long as you persist throughout your degree, you will have the same effective tuition rate for all four academic years



FEES

- **\$150** registration fee secures your spot in the Fall 2026 class start
- Uniform, chef coats & equipment fees vary based on program
 - Culinary Arts - **\$765**
 - Pastry Arts - **\$825**
 - Hospitality Management - **\$730**



HOUSING & MEAL PLANS

- **\$300** housing deposit secures your spot in the dorms
- Housing ranges from **\$7,800 - \$10,050** per academic year, depending on the housing assignment
- Residential Life students must have a meal plan, priced per academic year:
 - **\$5,400** - Full-range meal plan: about 18 meals per week
 - **\$3,600** - Mid-range meal plan: about 12 meals per week



DEADLINES

- **May 1st:** Priority housing deadline
- **July 1st:** Preferred uniform, chef coats & equipment deadline
- **August 1st:** Final deadline for **registration, uniform, chef coats, equipment, housing & first tuition payment** (i.e. loan for full balance secured or first payment of agreed upon payment plan submitted)
 - Payment plan options include per term or per month payments
